

YETE accountability return

You will recall when awarding a grant of \$10,000 to YETE in the 2017/18 financial year you made the award of future grants conditional upon them providing information to the Trust detailing the involvement of and outcomes achieved for Kuranui College students. Their report for the 12 months ended December 2018 is attached as Appendix 1. Note the tables on the second page of the report provide context for YETE's performance across the Wairarapa not just Greytown.

As it is the school holiday break I have not been able to speak to Simon Fuller, Kuranui Principal. However, he has in the past expressed continued support for the work that YETE is undertaking both with students and teachers.

A \$5,000 allocation has been included in the current 2019/20 budget for the purpose of providing further funding support to YETE. If you are satisfied with what their 2018 report indicates has occurred and been achieved, this allocation is available for you now to distribute in respect of the 2019 academic year.
