Who can apply?

The community funding round is open to all local community groups, incorporated societies and registered charities who currently operate within the Trust's defined geographical boundaries being the Greytown District Electoral Ward.

What can I apply for?

Community activities or projects that deliver a community-wide benefit to the Greytown district in the areas of ***"social, cultural and environmental well-being"***.

Applicants must be able to clearly demonstrate how the activity they are seeking funding for will benefit the Greytown community. Applications must not be for an individual.

Social	Organisations that help those in the community who are disadvantaged or in need. Organisations that help residents to participate in passive recreation activity or to bring them together in a community wide activity.
Cultural	Organisations, venues and events that encourage participation or promote interest in and enjoyment of arts, culture and local history.
Environmental	Initiatives that promote or deliver enhancements to local service infrastructure and to the local built and natural environment.

Application process

Complete this application form in full, attach copies of information required and submit via email to admin@greytowntrustlands.org.nz or hand deliver to our Trust office at 124 Main Street, Greytown.

Trustees will consider all eligible applications received as soon as possible after the closing date.

Successful applicants will be invited to the Trust's annual general meeting to be held on Tuesday 8 August at 7pm to be presented with their grant.

Evaluation Report

All grant recipients will be asked to complete an evaluation report following the activity / project explaining the difference the grant received has made to the community.

Do I have to return the funds if I don't spend it all?

Any unspent money should be returned to the Trust unless prior approval has been obtained from the Trust Manager.

Do I need to use all the funds for the project applied for?

Yes. Awarded funds must be applied to the purpose as stated in your application and not applied to any other purpose without the prior approval of the Trust Manager.

What sort of things can I apply for?

Any community project or activity that will result in a direct benefit to the Greytown community and its residents in the areas of social, cultural, environmental well-being.
